Rona Pondick at Sonnabend Gallery, through Apr. 27

It's been six years since Rona Pondick has shown in New York, and she returnswith a remarkable exhibition of exquisitely finished sculptures and delicate workson paper. The subject is hybridity. Tiny human faces sprout from the ends of branches; limbs of creatures morph into hands and fingers. Rendered in steel polished to a fetishistic sheen or bronze painted a perfect, milky white, and as malleable in contour as an Arp, the works reward extended viewing from all directions.
